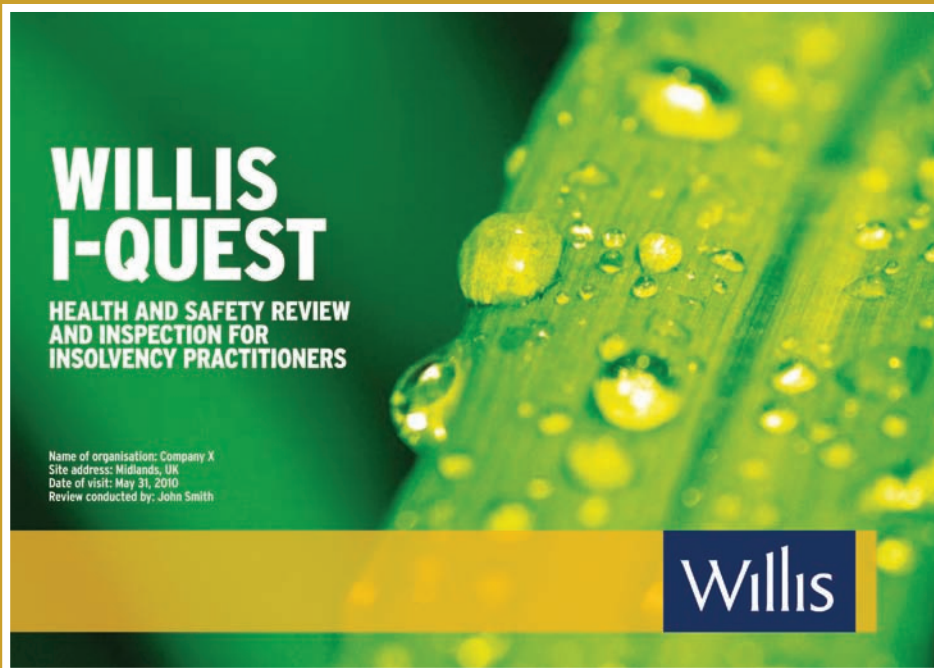

The Health and Safety Executive (HSE) National statistics report for Great Britain shows that in 2009/10 there were 26,061 major injuries and the rate of injury was 105.1 per 100,000.

In 2009/10 there were 1,033 offences prosecuted by HSE and ORR (Office of Rail Regulation). Of these, 922 were completed, resulting in 737 convictions (80%). These organisations found guilty of health and safety offences received fines totalling £11.6 million, giving average penalties on conviction of £15,817 per breach.
